## An Act Regarding the Operation of a Motorized or Electric Bicycle on a Public Way.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §101, sub-§41, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 4 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read: б 41. Motorized bicycle or tricycle. "Motorized bicycle or tricycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that: 8 A. May have pedals to permit human propulsion; and 10 B. Has a motor attached to a wheel that is rated at no more 12 than 1.5 brake horsepower and has a cylinder capacity net exceeding-50-cubic-contimetors; - and capable of propelling 14 the vehicle unassisted at a speed of 25 miles per hour or less on a level road surface. 16 C---Has-an-automatie-transmission-18 Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1254, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 20 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read: 22 3. Motorized bicycle or tricycle operator. A motorized bicycle or tricycle may only be operated by a person who 24 possesses a valid license of any class, an instruction permit or a license endorsed for a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle or 26 moped. The Secretary of State may not require the operator of a motorized bicycle or tricycle to obtain a license endorsed for a 28 motorcycle, motor-driven cycle or moped. 30 **SUMMARY** 32 This bill clarifies that a motorized bicycle or tricycle may 34 be operated by a person with a valid license of any class. This bill also amends the definition of motorized bicycle or tricycle.
