SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1069, L.D. 1500, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Trust Fund to Provide Statewide Assistance to Low-income Electric Consumers"


Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§4861.~~" in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the following: "fuel assistance" and inserting in its place the following: 'appliance replacement' and in the next to the last line (page 1, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "fuel assistance" and inserting in its place the following: 'appliance replacement'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§4864.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 46 and 47 in amendment) by striking out the following: "fuel assistance" and inserting in its place the following: 'appliance replacement'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§4864.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the 3rd line (page 3, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "fuel assistance" and inserting in its place the following: 'appliance replacement'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that funds in the Maine Low-income Energy Assistance Fund may be used for appliance replacement rather than for fuel assistance.
