COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 503, L.D. 1504

to a dedicated fund within the Commission on Governmental Ethics
and Election Practices will reduce General Fund revenue by
\$95,000 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01. There will
be no net effect on the commission's Other Special Revenue fund,
as this fund is reduced by \$47,500 each fiscal year from the
reduction in lobbyist registration fees, then increased by
\$47,500 due to dedicating all of the remaining lobbyist
registration fee revenue.

Authorizing the dedicated fund to accrue interest earnings will reduce General Fund revenue from interest earnings. Absent a detailed cash flow analysis of the dedicated fund, the amount of the reductions of General Fund revenue and the increases of dedicated revenue can not be determined at this time.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes provisions in the original bill pertaining to electronic filing. The bill retains only the provisions that reduce lobbying fees and requires that the fees be deposited in a dedicated account.

This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
