SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 511, L.D. 1512, Bill, "An Act to Amend Maine's Family and Medical Leave Law"

Amend the amendment in section 4 in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 36 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "than" the following: 'a total of'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in subsection 1 in the 8th and 9th lines (page 1, lines 38 and 39 in amendment) by striking out the following: "no more than 24 hours of family medical leave in each calendar year"

**SUMMARY**

This amendment limits to no more than a total of 24 hours annually the family medical leave available for attending necessary medical and dental appointments of a child and for attending parent-teacher conferences in a child's school.
