## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1319-O, sub-§1, ¶F is enacted to read: 4 F. The board shall adopt rules establishing alternative standards for the management of "universal waste," as defined in 6 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 273, Section 273.6. The rules must incorporate the set of management standards established in 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 273, Rules 8 10 adopted pursuant to this paragraph are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A. 12 **SUMMARY** 14 16 This bill requires the Board of Environmental Protection to adopt rules for the management of certain hazardous wastes, 18 including batteries, pesticides and thermostats, that are managed under the federal universal waste rules. The rules must 20 incorporate the management standards established in the federal rules regarding universal waste. 22
