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	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
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	This bill proposes to amend the current law to establish a
10	procedure to deal with defendants who are found incompetent to
	stand trial by a court. Under the procedure established by this
12	bill, a defendant found incompetent to stand trial would be
	ordered by the court to be confined by the State for the purpose
14	of obtaining treatment. The defendant would be confined until
	the court found that the person was competent to stand trial.
