

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

10 This bill proposes to increase local road assistance funds
12 to towns for use in special erosion control projects on town
14 roads located in lake watershed areas. These additional funds
would be provided to towns on a project-by-project basis and only
upon application by the town. The bill also proposes to consider
direct impacts from state aid and federal aid highways in
projects funded through existing highway lake protection programs.
