SUMMARY

20 This amendment adds 2 members who are Legislators to the Public Water Supply Protection Task Force. It requires the task force to evaluate fuel handling problems that lead to groundwater 22 contamination from fuel and fuel additives, including MTBE. It 24 permits the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis to provide additional staffing assistance to the task force at the request 26 of the chairs.
