This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$100,000 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 for the Department of Human Services to provide additional funding for Meals on Wheels.'

SUMMARY

This is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.

This amendment removes the requirement for the Department of Human Services to contract for a toll-free telephone number, reduces the appropriation for Meals on Wheels, eliminates the funding for the Senior One-Stop Program, changes the title of the bill and adds a fiscal note.
