APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$176,590 \$202,120

This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$176,590
and \$202,120 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively,
for the Department of Human Services to provide additional
funding for Meals on Wheels and contracts to establish the Senior
One-Stop Program.

No funding for these initiatives is currently included in
the Governor's proposed supplemental, "Part 2", budget.'

SUMMARY

This is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee
on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.

This amendment appropriates \$100,000 per year for the Meals
on Wheels program within the Department of Human Services and
\$76,590 for fiscal year 1999-00 and \$102,120 for fiscal year
2000-01 for the toll-free telephone number for incoming calls to
the Senior One-Stop Program. It also adds a fiscal note to the
bill.
