An Act to Maintain the Viability of Maine's Liquor Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §452, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, 4 Pt. A, $\S4$, is amended to read: 6 1. Location. File application with bureau. An applicant for a liquor 50 license or for the transfer of ownership or location of a liquor license, pursuant to this chapter, shall file an application in the form required by the bureau. The bureau shall create all forms necessary to acquire or transfer a license pursuant to this chapter. In the event the bureau has not created and made available the applicable form at the time an applicant seeks to file any application permitted by this Title, the applicant may file the application in writing in a form of the applicant's own choosing.

SUMMARY

This bill serves to preserve the viability of the State's 14 retail liquor industry by streamlining the process for transferring retail and agency liquor store licenses to locations 16 within the same municipality and by removing the restrictions on the number of agency store licenses that may be granted by the 18 bureau.
