COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 524, L.D. 1558, "Resolve, to Provide Incentives for School Breakfast Programs in Maine Public Schools"

Amend the resolve in section 3 in the caption "**EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF**" in that part designated "**School Breakfast Program**" in the 3rd line (page 1, line 42 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "funds" the following: 'on a one-time basis'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$240,000

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$240,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 for the Department of Education for grants designed to encourage public schools to establish school breakfast programs. No funding for this program is currently included in the Governor's proposed "Part 2" budget.

The additional costs associated with adopting rules and administering the grant program can be absorbed by the Department of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
