2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §107**, amended by PL 1983, c. 594, §3, is
repealed and the following enacted in its place:

6 **§107. Qualifications for appointment of Adjutant General and**
8 **assistant adjutant general**

10 **A person appointed Adjutant General or assistant adjutant**
12 **general must have served at least 5 years in the Maine National**
Guard and must have attained the federally recognized rank of
Colonel in the Maine National Guard.
