| Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:  |

| Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §3300-A is enacted to read:  |
| §3300-A. Identification of persons prescribing medicines on  |
| prescription blanks  |
| A physician who writes a prescription upon a prescription blank shall sign the physician's name and cause that name to be          |
| printed, stamped or typed below the signature so that the name of the physician is clearly legible. The physician's identification |
| number must be included with the name for identification purposes by a pharmacist.   |

| SUMMARY  |
| This bill requires a physician to print, stamp or type the physician's name below the signature blank for prescriptions in         |
| order for pharmacists to identify the physician requesting the prescription. The physician's identification number must also be    |
| printed, stamped or typed alongside the physician's name.  |
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
