COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1108, L.D. 1567, Bill, "An Act to Help Farmers to Protect the Quality of Milk"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §2903-B is enacted to read:

§2903-B. Testing of samples for resolving disputed test results

The commissioner shall develop a process for obtaining and testing a sample of milk when a milk producer disputes the result of a test or a component analysis performed by an employee of a milk plant that is used to determine acceptance of milk by the milk plant or payment to the milk producer.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will incur some minor additional costs to develop a certain milk sampling process. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'
