30	FISCAL NOTE
32	This bill will increase the costs for vehicle, general tort and police professional liability insurances provided by the Risk
34	Management Division within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services. The total estimated increase in annual
36	insurance costs is estimated to be approximately \$222,000 annually. The agencies most affected by these increases will be
38	the Department of Transportation and the Department of Public Safety. These increases will also affect the costs of providing
40	vehicles through central fleet management which will be passed on to agencies utilizing this central service.

44	The impact of this bill by program and by fund can not be estimated at this time.'
