Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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		Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §8105, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1987, c. 740	,
4	§5,	is further amended to read:	

1. Limit established. In any claim or cause of action permitted by this chapter, the award of damages, including costs, against either a governmental entity or its employees, or both, shall may not exceed \$399,000 \$500,000 for any and all claims arising out of a single occurrence.

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SUMMARY

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This bill increases the liability limit under the Maine Tort Claims Act from \$300,000 to \$500,000.
