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

**Sec. 1. Rulemaking regarding elderly low-cost drug program.**

2 **Resolved:** That by December 1, 1999, the Department of Human  
Services shall adopt rules making prescription pharmaceuticals  
4 available under the elderly low-cost drug program for the  
treatment of cancer. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are  
6 routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes,  
Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

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**SUMMARY**

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This resolve requires the Department of Human Services to  
adopt rules to add drugs for cancer to the elderly low-cost drug  
14 program by December 1, 1999.

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
