Sec. 1. Rulemaking regarding elderly low-cost drug program. Resolved: That by December 1, 1999, the Department of Human Services shall adopt rules making prescription pharmaceuticals available under the elderly low-cost drug program for the treatment of cancer. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.
