## **SUMMARY**

4 This amendment is the majority report for the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. Except as otherwise 6 allowed by law, it requires tobacco to be displayed or offered for sale only in a manner that does not allow the purchaser 8 direct access to the tobacco products. It exempts tobacco specialty stores and locations in which the presence of minors is generally prohibited. It states that the provision does not 10 preempt a municipal ordinance that provides for more restrictive 12 regulation of the sale of tobacco products. It also adds a fiscal note.
