30	Except for state-operated mental health hospitals, all
32	hospitals licensed by the department are subject to an annual assessment under this chapter. The department shall collect the
34	assessment. The amount of the assessment must be based upon each hospital's gross patient service revenue. For any fiscal year,
36	the aggregate amount raised by the assessment must-be-oqual-to the-amount-allocated-by-law-to-carry-out-the-purposes-of-this
38	chapterinthatfiscalyear <u>may not exceed \$200,000</u> . The allocation-for-the-fiscal-years-1995-96 and 1996-97-is-limited-to

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 536, L.D. 1598

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2 SUMMARY 4 This amendment replaces the bill. It removes repeal of the 6 provision that the amount of the assessment is based on each hospital's gross patient service revenue. It retains the 8 provision limiting the assessment to \$200,000 per fiscal year. 1t retains repeal of an outdated provision. It applies these 10 provisions retroactively to July 1, 1998.

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
