Sec. 1. 22 MRSA  $\S1887$ , as amended by PL 1995, c. 232,  $\S6$ , is further amended to read:

### §1887. Assessment

Except for state-operated mental health hospitals, hospitals licensed by the department are subject to an annual assessment under this chapter. The department shall collect the assessment. The amount of the assessment must be based upon each hespital's-gress-patient-service-revenue. For any fiscal year, the aggregate amount raised by the assessment must be equal-te the -- amount -- alleeated - by -- law -- to -- carry - out -- the -- purposes -- of -- this chapter-in-that-fiscal-year \$200,000. The-allocation-for-the fiscal--years--1995--96--and--1996--97--is--limited--to--no--more--than \$200,000-per-year. The department shall deposit funds collected under this section into a dedicated revenue account. remaining in the account at the end of each fiscal year do not lapse but carry forward into subsequent years. Funds deposited into the account must be allocated to carry out the purposes of this chapter.
