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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 539, L.D. 1601, "Resolve, to Direct the Department of Environmental Protection and the Department of Economic and Community Development to Devise a Proposal for Long-term Funding of the Removal of Tire Dumps"

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Amend the resolve in the 4th indented paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "long-term"

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Further amend the resolve in the 5th indented paragraph after the title in the 3rd line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "long-term"

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Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "devise a system for entering into long-term" and inserting in its place the following: 'review options for entering into'

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Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "ensure" the following: 'long-term'

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Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "activities." and inserting in its place the following: 'activities in connection with their review of funding issues. The commissioners shall review alternative funding issues including additional fees charged to a purchaser of tires and the use or sale of waste tires for fuel.'

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Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 8th line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "long-term"

(page 1, line 34 in L.D.) by striking out the following:

6 Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 14th line

8 "ensure" the following: 'long-term'

10 Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the
summary the following:

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FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Economic and Community Development and the
16 Department of Environmental Protection will incur some additional
costs to review options related to contracting for and funding
18 tire abatement and site remediation activities and reporting the
results to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within
20 the departments' existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that the Commissioner
26 of Environmental Protection and the Commissioner of Economic and
Community Development devise a system for entering into long-term
28 contracts with tire abatement and site remediation contractors
and further specifies that the commissioners review alternative
30 funding issues for dealing with waste tires. The amendment also
adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
