30	The estimated cost of sending this constitutional amendment out to referendum will vary according to the total number of	
32	referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 119th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The	
34	estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an	
36	additional \$7,000.	
38	If approved by the voters, the Department of the Secretary of State will incur some minor additional costs concerning the	
40	distribution of absentee ballots. These costs can be absorbed within the Bureau of Corporations, Elections and Commissions'
