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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 545, L.D. 1607, "RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Revoke
Voting Rights of Convicted Felons While they are in Prison"

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Amend the resolution by striking out the title and
substituting the following:


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'RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine
to Revoke Voting Rights of Convicted Felons While They Are in
Prison and to Revoke Voting Rights of Persons Convicted of
Treason'

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Further amend the resolution in that part designated
"Section 1." in the first paragraph in the 4th line from the end
(page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by inserting after the following:
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"State" the following: 'nor may any person convicted of treason
be entitled to the right of suffrage'

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Further amend the resolution in that part designated
"Constitutional referendum procedure; form of question; effective date."
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in the question in the last line (page 1, line 48 in L.D.) by
inserting after the following: "imprisoned" the following: 'and
to revoke the right of a person convicted of treason to vote'
