16	This bill amends the laws governing incentive scholarships by permitting a student to receive a scholarship if the student
18	meets the satisfactory academic progress policy of the
	institution that the student attends rather than limiting the
20	award of a scholarship to a period of 8 semesters. This change
	is consistent with recent changes in federal law.
