Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17806, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1993, c. 595, §6, is further amended to read:

Cost-of-living adjustments under this 6 3. **Eligibility.** section must be applied to the retirement benefits of all retirees who have been retired for at least 12 months before the 8 date that the adjustment becomes payable, -- on or other -- that -- -- member who-has-less-than-10-years-of-creditable-service-on-July-1,-1993 10 may -- not -- receive--a - cost-of-living--adjustment -- until--at -- least -- 12 12 months--aftor-reaching--normal-rotiremont-age. Beneficiaries of deceased retirees and members are eligible for the cost-of-living 14 adjustment at the same time the deceased retiree or member would have become eligible. A member who is eligible to retire as of June 30, 1993 and who actually retires effective no later than 16 July 1, 1994 is eligible for the cost-of-living adjustment if 18 that member has been retired for at least 6 months before the date that the adjustment becomes payable.

SUMMARY

This bill reinstates the cost-of-living adjustment for retirement system members who retire before normal retirement age.
