18 This bill includes General Fund appropriations totalling  
20 \$170,000 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 for the  
Department of Economic and Community Development. Of this  
22 amount, \$120,000 annually is appropriated for the Office of  
Business Development to contract for a program to serve currently  
underserved and economically depressed areas. Appropriations of  
24 \$50,000 annually are provided to support the Forum Francophone.  
No funding for these programs is currently included in the  
26 Governor's proposed "Part 2" budget.'

30 **SUMMARY**

32 This amendment is the majority report. The amendment  
strikes the original bill and replaces it with General Fund  
appropriations to the Department of Economic and Community  
34 Development for contracts for 2 field representatives in  
currently underserved and economically depressed areas and  
provides funds to support the Forum Francophone. The amendment  
36 also adds a fiscal note.
