SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 571, L.D. 1638, "Resolve, to Review Traffic Congestion Including Truck Traffic along the Route 1 York Corridor"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'Resolve, to Review Traffic Congestion Including Truck Traffic along the Route 1 York Corridor and Route 236 Corridor'**

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the resolve in the 2nd indented paragraph after the title in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Route 1" the following: ', Route 236'

Further amend the resolve in the 3rd indented paragraph after the title in the 3rd line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "corridor" the following: ', the Route 236 corridor'

Further amend the resolve in the 4th indented paragraph after the title in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "corridor" the following: ', the Route 236 corridor'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Corridor" the following: 'and the Route 236 Corridor"

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "12" and inserting in its place the following: '11'

2 Further amend the resolve in section 2 by striking out all of subsections 3 and 4 and inserting in their place the following:

4 '3. A representative of each of the following towns, designated by the manager of each town: Berwick, Eliot, Kittery, Ogunquit, South Berwick, Wells and York; and be it further'

8 Further amend the resolve in section 5 by striking out all of subsections 1 and 2 and inserting in their place the following:

10 '1. Past, current and projected traffic flows and patterns along U.S. Route 1, Route 236, the Maine Turnpike and other major roadways in the York County area between Kittery and Berwick and between Kittery and Wells;

16 2. Vehicular accident rates in the U.S. Route 1 York and the Route 236 corridors;'

18 Further amend the resolve in section 5 by striking out all of subsection 5 and inserting in its place the following:

22 '5. Current local roadway signage, traffic signals, local traffic conditions and patterns and the increased number of curb cuts and their effect on traffic congestion;'

26 Further amend the resolve in section 5 by striking out all of subsection 7 and inserting in its place the following:

28 '7. State and local law enforcement coverage along the U.S. Route 1 York and the Route 236 corridors; and be it further'

32 Further amend the resolve in section 9 in the 6th and 7th lines (page 3, lines 21 and 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and a per diem equal to the legislative per diem" '

36 Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

**FISCAL NOTE**

42 This amendment does not affect the General Fund cost of the resolve. The General Fund appropriation in the bill does not include funds for the payment of per diem for public members.


