If an extension of the reporting deadline is granted and the commission requires staffing 34 assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff services. 36 38 The Department of Transportation, the Department of Public Safety and the Maine Turnpike Authority will incur some minor 40 additional costs to participate in the study to be conducted by the commission.
