HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1156, L.D. 1653, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Law Governing the Confidentiality of Health Care Information"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "PART A" in section 5 in that part designated "§1711-C." in subsection 6 in paragraph F-1 in the first line (page 10, line 12 in amendment) by striking out the following: ";" and inserting in its place the following: 'or'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "PART A" in section 5 in that part designated "§1711-C." in subsection 6 in paragraph F-1 in the 2nd to 4th lines (page 10, lines 13 to 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "; or as directed by subpoena issued on behalf of a governmental entity for the purpose of an investigation or prosecution"

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the authority of a governmental entity or agent of such an entity to direct disclosure of confidential health care information by subpoena without consent.
