SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1156, L.D. 1653, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Law Governing the Confidentiality of Health Care Information"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 5 in subsection 6 by striking out all of paragraph F-1 and inserting in its place the following:

'F-1. As directed by order of a court or as authorized or required by statute;

F-2. To a governmental entity pursuant to a lawful subpoena requesting health care information to which the governmental entity is entitled according to statute or rules of court;'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies the ability of a health care practitioner or facility to disclose health care information pursuant to subpoena from a governmental entity.
