

SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 575, L.D. 1655, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Laws Regarding Fund Raising During the Legislative Session"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C-1 in the 7th and 8th lines (page 1, lines 31 and 32 in L.D.) by striking out all of the following: "nor the advertisement of the expected presence of any such official at any such event."

SUMMARY

This amendment removes that portion of the bill that would allow the advertisement of the expected presence of the Governor, a member of the Legislature or any constitutional officer or the staff or agent of any of those persons at fund-raising events held by a political party.
