Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1313, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 468, 4 §23, is amended to read:

SUMMARY

This bill requires all rabies testing to be funded through a 26 yearly appropriation from the State's General Fund to the Health and Environmental Testing Laboratory within the Department of 28 Human Services, Bureau of Health. Current state law requires all laboratory costs, including transportation, quarantine, euthanasia and testing of undomesticated animals to be paid by 30 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife the and all 32 laboratory costs relating to a domesticated animal to be paid by the owner of that animal.
