Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 34-A MRSA §3036-A, sub-§2, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1991,
4 c. 845, §4, is repealed.

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SUMMARY

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10 This bill repeals the law that prohibits the transferring of
a prisoner to supervised community confinement with more than one
year remaining on the term of imprisonment or on the unsuspended
12 portion of a split sentence.
