COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1173, L.D. 1684, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 306: Uniform Disclosure and Informational Filing Requirements, a Major Substantive Rule of the Public Utilities Commission"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "authorized." and inserting in its place the following: 'authorized only if the rule is amended to:

1. Require that the disclosure label be provided to customers on a quarterly basis rather than on a semiannual basis.

The Public Utilities Commission is not required to hold hearings or conduct other formal proceedings prior to finally adopting the rule in accordance with this resolve.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Public Utilities Commission may incur some minor additional costs to administer provisions related to disclosures and informational filings by competitive electricity providers. These costs can be absorbed within the commission's existing budgeted resources.'
