HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1179, L.D. 1690, Bill, "An Act Regulating the Transportation of People and Dogs in Pickup Trucks"


Amend the amendment on page 1 by inserting after paragraph A the following:

'B. Licensed hunters being transported to or from a hunting location, as long as those persons are in compliance with all laws pertaining to possession and transportation of firearms in a motor vehicle;'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a 4th exception to the bill's prohibition on persons under 19 years of age riding in the back of a pickup truck. The exception added by this amendment is the exception for licensed hunters who are being transported to or from a hunting location, provided they are in compliance with all applicable laws pertaining to the possession and transportation of firearms in a motor vehicle.
