COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1189, L.D. 1699, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Compliance With Disability Access Laws by the Baxter State Park Authority"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§903-A." in subsection 1 in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 7 and 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Notwithstanding sections 900 and 903, the" and inserting in its place the following: 'The'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§903-A." by striking out all of subsection 2.

SUMMARY

This amendment is the committee minority report. It removes the preadoption provisions for rulemaking in the original bill. It also removes language in the bill that "notwithstands" the purpose section in law for Baxter State Park. The purpose section contains references to Governor Baxter's expressed desires for the park.
