HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1191, L.D. 1701, "Resolve, to Increase Access to Maine's Technical College System"

Amend the resolve in section 2 by striking out all of the 6th and 7th lines (page 1, lines 14 and 16 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

**Maine Technical College System -
Board of Trustees**

All Other \$1,500,000 \$3,000,000

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

1999-00 2000-01

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$1,500,000 \$3,000,000

This resolve includes General Fund appropriations of \$1,500,000 and \$3,000,000 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for the Maine Technical College System to increase enrollment by approximately 1,000 students.

No funding for this expansion is currently included in the Governor's proposed "Part 2" budget.'


