	The Peer Support Program for Displaced Workers is created
30	within the department to provide advocacy and information for
32	workers displaced by significant layoffs. The program may
32	initiate one or more projects to assist employees as provided in this chapter and as resources permit. The department is
34	authorized to use any available resources or to apply for federal
	grants to implement this chapter. Any funds appropriated by the
36	Legislature for a pilot program or this program may not lapse but
	must be carried forward.'

2	Sec. 3. Effective date. Section 1 of this Act takes effect July 1, 2000.''
4	FISCAL NOTE
<b>6</b>	The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$1,228,500 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01.
10	SUMMARY
12	This amendment clarifies that the Department of Labor is
14	authorized to use existing funds or apply for federal funding to continue the Peer Support Program for Displaced Workers in fiscal year 2000-01 and beyond. The amendment also requires the
16	Department of Labor to report to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor on the status of the pilot program funded in the "Part 2"
18	Budget, along with the availability of any funding to continue the program.
20	
22	This amendment also clarifies that the statutory language establishing the program would take effect on July 1, 2000.
24	Finally, it eliminates the General Fund appropriations included in the bill through Committee Amendment "A".
