HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 607, L.D. 1730

This amendment includes a General Fund appropriation of
\$1,078,781 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Retired Teachers'
Health Insurance account within the Department of Education to
increase the State's contribution for health insurance premiums
for retired educators from 30% to 35% on July 1, 2000 and from
35% to 40% on January 1, 2001. This amount is based on current
enrollment figures, as well as General Fund appropriations that
represent the State's 30% share of the cost of the premiums which
are included in Public Law 1999, chapter 16, the 2000-2001
"current services" budget and LD 2510, the Governor's proposed
supplemental budget.
