28	FISCAL NOTE

32	This amendment delays the date of the increase in the State's share for retired teachers' health insurance from July 1, 2000 to July 1, 2001, eliminating the General Fund cost of the
34	bill by \$913,500 in fiscal year 2000-01. As amended, this bill increases the State's share of retired teachers' health insurance
36	from 30% to 35% on July 1, 2001. The estimated General Fund appropriations that will be needed to fund this increase in
38	fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03 will be approximately \$780,961 and \$874,676, respectively.
