COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 608, L.D. 1731

2 General Fund

This bill will require the revision of the Regulation of Employment poster by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards. This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$12,134 in fiscal year 1999-00 for the Department of Labor for printing and mailing costs. If other bills are enacted that also require changes to the poster, the cost properly allocated to this bill can be reduced.

12 This bill may decrease the number of civil violations filed in the court system. The Judicial Department may realize some 14 minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no 16 longer be filed. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
