
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1214, L.D. 1743, Bill, "An Act to Preserve Live Harness Racing in the State"

Amend the amendment in subsection 10 in the 5th line from the end (page 1, line 36 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "\$100." the following: 'Telephone account wagers may not be placed using a credit card.'

**SUMMARY**

The bill, as amended by Committee Amendment "A," requires that money used to place telephone account wagers must be on deposit with the licensed facility in an amount sufficient to cover the wagers and allows the deposit to be in the form of a confirmed credit card transaction. This amendment clarifies that the actual telephone account wagers may not be placed using a credit card.
