Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §187-C is enacted to read:
§187-C. Suspension of interest and penalties during bankruptcy
The accumulation of interest and penalties imposed under
this Title for nonpayment or late payment of taxes are suspended from the date the taxpayer files a petition for relief under the
United States Bankruptcy Code until final distribution of asset
by the bankruptcy trustee.
SUMMARY
This bill provides for the suspension of interest and
penalties for nonpayment or late payment of taxes when the taxpayer files for bankruptcy.
