An Act to Correct Inconsistencies within the Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17851-A, sub-§1, ¶¶G and H, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 769, §11, are amended to read: 4 6 G. Liquor inspectors, including the Chief Inspector, in the employment of the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Liquor Enforcement on July 1, 1998, or hired thereafter; and 8 10 Firefighters in the employment of the Department of H. Veterans and Emergency Management at Bangor Defense, 12 International Airport on July 1, 1998, or hired thereafter, provided the Federal Government pays annually to the 14 retirement system the full employer cost of the participation of these employees -; and 16 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §17851-A, sub-§1, ¶I is enacted to read: 18 I. Investigators and inspectors in the employment of the 20 Department of Public Safety, Office of the State Fire Marshal on July 1, 1998, or hired thereafter. 22 Sec. 3. Retroactivity. This Act is retroactive to July 1, 1998. 24 26 **SUMMARY** 28 This bill adds investigators and inspectors employed by the Department of Public Safety, Office of the State Fire Marshal to 30

the special retirement plan referred to as the 1998 Special Plan.
