HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1229, L.D. 1758, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Victims' Compensation Fund Law"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 22 to 25 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 6 in the last line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "bodily injury or" '

This amendment changes language regarding the circumstances under which a victim is eligible for compensation based on psychological injury from the Victims' Compensation Fund.
