Sec. 1. Director of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations to investigate the requirements for Maine to join the PowerBall lottery. Resolved: That the Director of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations, referred to in this resolve as the "director," shall investigate the requirements for Maine to join the PowerBall lottery. Pursuant to this investigation the director shall contact the Multi-State Lottery Association and obtain all of the necessary information that will allow Maine to join the PowerBall lottery; and be it further

Sec. 2. Reporting date established. Resolved: That the director shall report the findings of the investigation, including any proposed legislation necessary to implement the PowerBall lottery in the State, to the Legislature by January 1, 2000.

SUMMARY

This resolve requires the Director of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations to investigate the requirements for Maine to join the PowerBall lottery, including contacting the Multi-State Lottery Association and obtaining all of the necessary information that will allow Maine to join the PowerBall lottery. The director shall report back to the Legislature by January 1, 2000 with the findings of the investigation and proposed legislation to implement the PowerBall lottery in the State.
