20 This resolve requires the Director of Alcoholic Beverages
and Lottery Operations to investigate the requirements for Maine
22 to join the PowerBall lottery, including contacting the
Multi-State Lottery Association and obtaining all of the
24 necessary information that will allow Maine to join the PowerBall
lottery. The director shall report back to the Legislature by
26 January 1, 2000 with the findings of the investigation and
proposed legislation to implement the PowerBall lottery in the
State.
