28	12. Application: mobile homes owned by park. If a park owner or operator owns a mobile home in the mobile home park and
30	rents that mobile home, termination of the tenancy is governed by the terms of the lease. If there is no lease agreement, the
32	tenancy is a tenancy at will and termination is governed by Title 14, section 6002.'

36	SUMMARY
38	This amendment replaces the bill. This amendment clarifies
40	that the laws governing the termination of a tenancy in a mobile home park apply only to tenants of space in the park and not to
42	tenants who are renting a mobile home owned by the owner or operator of the park. Termination of these tenancies are
44	governed by the terms of the lease, or, if there is no lease, in accordance with the law governing tenancies at will.
